Dear Discovery and Explorer Families,

As we are approaching March 1, and our return to full-day learning, we wanted to take a moment to communicate plans and procedures around food services that will be available to elementary students. Please review this important information. If you have any questions, contact the school office.

A free breakfast and lunch will be available to all Discovery and Explorer students.

Breakfast

- A typical breakfast will consist of a cereal bar, juice, and milk.
- Breakfast will not be served at school. It will be delivered to students at the end of the day to bring home and enjoy before coming to school the next day.

Lunch

- A lunch menu will be posted on our website and shared electronically with families each month. Here is the [March](#) menu.
- Any student who wishes to do so will have the opportunity to sign up for school lunch at the beginning of each day. A gluten free option will be available.
- School lunches will be delivered to the classroom.
- Students who bring their lunch from home should pack a lunch that does not require heating in a microwave. **Microwaves will not be available for student use.**

Safety Protocols

- Students will eat lunch in their classrooms so that they remain cohorted during lunchtime.
- Classroom teachers will supervise student lunchtime.
- Due to food allergies, some, but not all, classrooms may have food restrictions. Your classroom teacher will notify you of any restrictions.
- Students will wash hands before and after eating.
- Classroom dining spaces will be sanitized daily.
- School staff will work with families to ensure that plans are in place to support food allergies and other health needs impacted by lunchtime.
